▶ However, if you think a 6am finish is late enough, there are plenty of other changes to enjoy. Manumission has left its 7,000-capacity home at Privilege for the comparatively intimate Amnesia; Tiesto, the first DJ to attempt to fill London's O2 arena, moves in. And how to replace Pete Tong at Pacha? Book the stadium-filling dance acts Basement Jaxx and Faithless as residents, along with the new party sensations Swedish House Mafia. Steve Lawler returns to Sundays at Space, while the American DI Danny Tenaglia is a Thursday resident, his first regular commitment on the island.

Ibiza Rocks is back with a series of outdoor events that embrace those who would rather gig than club, including the launch of the Ibiza Rocks Hotel at a converted San Antonio tourist resort. With acts such as the Enemy, Reverend and the Makers, Soulwax and the Fratellis booked. why would you want to stand in the mud at Glastonbury?

The celebrities have arrived before the DJs this year, with the Brazilian supermodel Gisele returning to the island to launch her sunglasses range. The make-up artist Charlotte Tilbury is back working on fashion shoots and Jade Jagger is as visible as ever. Then there is the small matter of Wayne Rooney's stag week in June. Bafflingly, he has requested 40-strong guest lists, but not the fashionable vodka-bottle service, the most cost-effective way of experiencing the best clubs. Elsewhere, Kylie Minogue, Robert Plant and Chas from Madness have all purchased houses in the hills. See what I mean about Ibiza making people cool?
